

HELPFUL THINGS TO KNOW FOR YOUR VISIT

- **Sunday School** classes for all ages begin at 9:30 A.M. (Sept.-June). Adult Bible Study continues through the summer. **Nursery** care is available at 9:30 A.M. (Sept.-June) and at 10:00 A.M. (July-August).
- **Worship** begins at 10:55 A.M. with **Holy Communion** on the first Sunday of month. In summer, an additional outdoor worship service is held at 9:00 A.M.
- **Ushers** are available to assist you with all your needs — just ask for help.
- **Hearing devices** for the hearing impaired are available for worship.
- Be sure to use the blue **Fellowship Pad** located at the end of each pew.
- After the Children's Time in worship (Sept.-June), children in 3rd grade and younger may stay with parents or go to our **Nursery**.
- **Prayer requests** may be made by using the prayer request cards in the pews and then placed in the offering plate.
- Join us in the **Fellowship Hall** immediately following worship for coffee, refreshments and a chance to meet other worshippers.

Heritage is a welcoming congregation! **Worship** is held in the Sanctuary at 10:55 A.M. each Sunday, immediately followed by coffee and refreshments in our Fellowship Hall. During the summer months we hold an additional worship service at 9:00 A.M. During our 10:55 A.M. service, children in 3rd grade and younger are invited to stay with their parents during worship, or they may go to our **Nursery** for quiet playtime. On the first Sunday of each month, **Holy Communion** is celebrated. The Communion table is open to all who are professed Christians. Heritage is also blessed with a **music ministry** that includes choirs and handbell and handchime ensembles.

As disciples of Jesus Christ, Heritage focuses on biblically-based sermons and Christian education for all ages. Our **Sunday School** classes for ages 4 and up meet every Sunday morning at 9:30 (Sept.-June). **Childcare** is available for children 3 years and younger in our Nursery on Sunday mornings beginning at 9:30 (Sept.-June) and at 10:00 (July-Aug.). We also have a variety of Bible study small groups and circles for **adults** throughout the month, as well as a vibrant **Youth Group**. Additionally, each summer Heritage holds a week-long **Vacation Bible School** for kids ages 3 through 4th grade.
